WALT: use noun phrases

Below are some examples of noun phrases. Noun phrases usually include a noun (a person, place or thing) and the adjectives used to describe them.

Constructing an Expanded Noun Phrase

An expanded noun phrase is a phrase made up of a noun and at least one adjective.

a fast tiger

adjective noun

Constructing an Expanded Noun Phrase

If you list more than one adjective to describe the noun, you should add a comma to separate them

a fast, fierce tiger

adjective comma noun

Constructing an Expanded Noun Phrase

A determiner is used to introduce a noun to specify which one or how many.

a fast, fierce tiger

determiner adjective comma adjective noun

Constructing an Expanded Noun Phrase

a fluffy, warm scarf

determiner adjective comma adjective noun

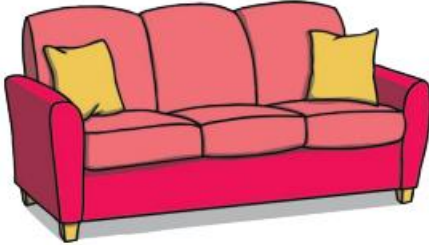
