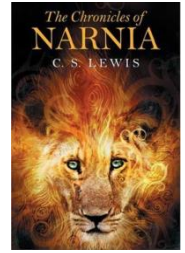


**Journalism club are hosting a competition.

What do you have to do: read a book and write a review on it. Here is some information to help you.

Writing book reviews helps other readers decide if they want to read the book for themselves. Why not share a review of a book you've recently read and tell others what you thought of it? What to do with your reviews:

Write a review or give stars out of 5 (5 being fantastic!) on a piece of paper.

Reviews usually include the following information:

- Title
- Author
- Illustrator (if any)
- Is it Fiction, Non-Fiction, Picture Book, Poetry, Graphic Novel, etc?
- Recommended age
- Brief summary of the book (but not giving away any spoilers or endings!)
- Main character(s)
- Strengths/weaknesses of the book
- A rating (sometimes stars) or recommendation. Think about...
- The language and vocabulary used.
- If there are illustrations or photos, what are they like and how do they complement the book?
- What type of genre or subject is it about (humour, mysteries, animals, etc)?
