Help and support for Families

We recognise that at times families may need some extra help, signposting or support, often this can be from friends, family or someone in the community but sometimes more may be required. Below are some of the places you might be able to find out more about the right support for your child and family.

Schools Offers

At Ivington CE Primary and Pre-School, we are committed to providing comprehensive pastoral support to ensure the well-being and emotional development of all our pupils. Below, you will find information about the in-house pastoral support available to your child:

- ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support Assistants): We are fortunate to have two trained ELSAs in school who work with children to develop their emotional literacy and resilience.
- **Drawing and Talking:** This is an emotional literacy intervention designed to help children process their emotions and feelings through creative means.
- Vennture: A support service that provides practical and emotional assistance to our pupils, fostering a supportive school community.
- **Butterflies Play Therapy:** This therapeutic approach uses play to help children work through emotional difficulties and enhance their emotional well-being.
- Signposting to CLD (Community Learning Development): We guide and refer families
 to CLD services for additional support outside of school, ensuring a holistic support
 network for our pupils.

If you believe your child would benefit from any of these support services, please reach out to our school office to discuss your child's needs and how we can assist. We may require consent for certain interventions.

Messy Church

Messy Church is for people of all ages and great for families. We meet once a month, usually on a Thursday from 4-6pm.

Upcoming dates are January 16th February 13th and March 20th at Leominster Priory. We have a different Bible story as our theme each month and explore it with lots of creativity often including paint and glue, science, colouring for grown ups, outdoor fun, edible crafts, reflective spaces, bubbles, playdough, junk modelling, and growing things.

Everyone gets to join in. We have a short celebration time lasting about 15 minutes where we think about the story, sing and say a prayer and then we all have a meal together before we go home.

If you can't come every time, that's ok - we'll always be pleased to see you and if some of your family want to come just for the meal, that's fine too.

Messy Church is a great place to get to know other families. If you don't believe in God or aren't sure what you believe, that's ok! You are very welcome! We don't charge anything for Messy Church so we always welcome donations and cakes!

Further help and support available in Herefordshire

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Often families can solve their own problems, at times they may need support. If you need any advice or support for your child or your family, we recommend you share your worry with a professional you feel comfortable talking to or call CHAT (Children's Help and Advice Team within Early Help) if that works better for you and speak to an advisor.

A CHAT advisor can give advice over the phone, send you out information and signposting, or if needed, arrange a package of support through an Early Help Assessment to access a family support worker if required. This could include support from Children's Centre Services (for families with children aged 5 or under) or Early Help Family Support (for families with children 0-18, or up to 25 years with SEND)
