Sir Christopher Wren

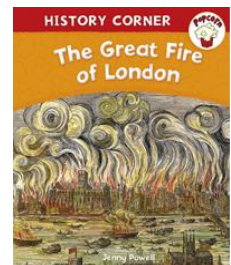
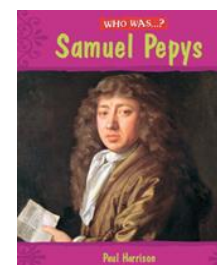


A famous architect who designed many buildings, especially after the Great Fire of London. He's best known for designing St. Paul's Cathedral.
