VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOLS

- 1. The name of the school is: IVINGTON CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL
- 2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
- 3. The name of the governing body is: The Governing Body of Ivington Church of England Primary School
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) 7 foundation governors
 - (b) 2 parent governors;
 - (c) 1 LA governor;
 - (d) staff governors (to include the Headteacher, whether he/she wishes to be a governor);
- 5. Total number of governors is 12.
- 6. The term of office for Parent Governors shall be **TWO** years and for all other categories of governor is **FOUR** years.
- 7. Appointment of Foundation Governors

Either:

(a) **ONE** of the foundation governors shall be *The Principal Officiating Minister for the time being in the parish of Leominster*

Or:

(b) The Archdeacon of Hereford shall appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 23(2) of the Regulations.

The remaining will be appointed by the Hereford Board of Education in consultation with Ivington Parochial Church Council and Leominster Parochial Church Council.

8. Ethos Statement

"Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils".

- 9. The instrument of government comes into effect on: 1st June 2015
- 10. The instrument is made by order of the Local Education Authority of the County of Herefordshire District Council (also known as "Herefordshire Council")
