School Uniform

Girls: Red polo shirt and grey skirt / pinafore / trousers with a navy cardigan or sweatshirt

PE: Red T-shirt, navy hoodie, black shorts / skirt / tracksuit bottoms and trainers

Boys: Red polo shirt, grey trousers / shorts with a navy sweatshirt

PE: Red T-shirt, navy hoodie, black shorts / tracksuit bottoms and trainers

Large logos and slogans on sportswear must be avoided.

For health and safety reasons, jewellery (other than a small stud) is not allowed in school. Studs must be covered before coming to school on PE days.

Please ensure that uniform and belongings are labelled with your child's name - it makes it easier for us to reunite them with their owners.
