Dear Parents and Carers

Your children have coped well with the warm weather so far. However, with temperatures forecast to rise further over the coming days, I wanted to reassure you that we are taking all reasonable steps to keep children safe and comfortable while at school.

To help ensure the wellbeing of all pupils during the hot weather, we will maintain the measures already in place, including:

- Encouraging children to drink water regularly throughout the day
- Ventilating classrooms as effectively as possible
- Keeping children indoors during the hottest parts of the day to minimise heat exposure

Due to the current extreme heat alert, although Ivington will remain open, we are offering families the option to collect their children early at 1.00pm on Wednesday and Thursday. Please note that this is entirely optional and the school will remain fully open for those children who stay for the full day.
